

## School supplies for 4<sup>th</sup> grade

Dear Parents of 4th grade,

To have a great start into the new school year, I ask you to provide your child with the following supplies:

- 3 Writing journals with lines DIN A 4 with border (2 practice journals and 1 essay journal); red, orange, yellow cover
- 3 small DIN A 5 journals lined without border (puple, turquoise, light blue)
- 2 math journals with squares DIN A 4 with border (dark blue)
- 1 DIN A5 journal with squares without border (light blue)
- 1 DIN A4 journal without lines (HSU - science and social studies), green cover
- 1 DIN A4 journal with lines without border (English); purple cover
- 1 writing pad DIN A 4 (squares)
- 1 writing pad DIN A 4 (lined)
- 1 drawing pad DIN A 3
- 1 portfolio DIN A 3 (to collect their art work)
- Loose leaf binder: red (German), blue (Math), green (Social Studies and Science), white (Music), yellow (Religious Ed), purple (English), black
- Minimum of 3 paint brushes, eventually additional paint brushes; water colors (12 colors); Painting gown (old shirt), cloth, sponge, everything in a box; oil crayons
- 1 glue stick; 1 scissors; sharpener in pencil box or bag
- Homework journal
- 1 Jurismappe (folder)
- Eraser; Ink pen (Füller) with replacement ink cartridges and erasable ink pencil; 1 non-permanent marker; black Fineliner; 2 pencil (please make sure these are sharpened at all times); 1 protractor; 1 compass;

Of course your child may continue to use journals started during 3rd grade. If your child has problems with the lines or squares, you may purchase journals with larger spaced lines or squares. I also ask to provide your child with a ring binder, storage box and magazine file. Please label all supplies with the name of your child. Thank you!

Additionally, the following work journals are planned for next school year (these will be ordered by the school at the beginning of the school year):

German: Piri Arbeitsheft 4, Zauberlehrling 4

Math: Welt der Zahl 4, Rechentrainer 4
