

School Bus Rules

- 1. The most important rule: Never cross the road in front or behind a stopping bus! Always wait until the bus departs, then make sure that the road is clear before crossing.
- 2. Arrive at the bus stop on time. You should arrive at the bus stop five minutes prior to departure time.
- 3. Always remember: The bus stop is not a playground! Playing children can accidentally get on the.
- 4. Keep a minimum of one meter distance between yourself and a bus driving up or departing.
- 5. Follow the instructions of the bus driver and the bus monitor.
- 6. Entering or exiting the bus happens faster and safer without pushing or shoving. When entering or exiting the bus hold on tight to the handles.
- 7. Find a free seat and sit down. Reserving seats is not permitted! Please move over when classmates would like to sit down beside you.
- 8. Backpacks or bags must be placed on the floor in front of the seat or held in the lap.
 Backpacks must not be placed in the center aisle as a classmate could trip over it.
 Additionally, backpacks must not be placed on the seats as other students would like to sit down as well.
- 9. Remain seated during the entire bus ride. Running, romping around or fighting is prohibited.
- 10. If no seats are available, look for a safe place to stand and hold on firmly. Avoid the area of the stairway.
- 11. Willful destruction or soiling of the bus and its equipment is prohibited! Please inform the driver if you notice any damages.
